Our **Eighth Annual Kids and Conservation Video Contest** is open to high school students (13 years and older, including those who are home-schooled) within NJNG's service territory.

Here are the details:

- Both individual and group video projects are accepted. NJNG will award one individual video winner **\$500** and one group video winner will receive **\$2,500 for their club or class**. The winning students' schools will each receive a **\$1,000 contribution** from NJNG toward an energy conservation or environmental project.
- Our community partner, the Asbury Park Press, will display the individual and group finalists' videos on *app.com*, where the public will vote for an additional Viewer's Choice award of **\$500** from NJNG.
- Videos should be no more than two minutes in length and **highlight natural gas energy conservation efforts or ideas**.
- Visit the Save Energy & Money section of *njng.com* for free resource material for your video. Natural gas conservation efforts should be the primary focus of the video (such as heating, water heating and cooking).
