## Who can participate?

All submissions must be accompanied by:

- A completed entry form
- A completed consent form

Upon submission, a confirmation email will be sent once the entry is received.

### What are the requirements to participate?

Students will create a poster that illustrates energy-saving and conservation tips. Students must use an 8 ½" x 11" piece of plain white paper (supplied by the school). NJNG encourages students to be creative – using any art medium except clip art or 3-D designs. The poster must be a student's original work.

#### How are winners selected?

NJNG team members will judge the posters based on the following criteria: content, accuracy, creativity, and overall presentation. NJNG will select three winners to receive prizes. See the Official Rules for prize details. All participating students will receive a certificate of recognition for their participation.
