Q. What topics are there to choose from?

To inspire your video, there are two themes to select from this year:

The Energy Detective: Uncovering Hidden Waste

 Investigate overlooked energy waste in your home or school and demonstrate or identify creative, practical solutions to reduce it.

My Energy Footprint: A Personal Journey

 Document your personal energy use and share the steps you're taking to reduce your footprint —at home, school, or in your community.

Video Creation

Q. What type of video can I create?

Be creative! Use skits, narration, interviews, animation, or any format that brings your story to life. Just make sure your video is clear, engaging, and aligned with one of this year's themes.

Q. Can I film on a smartphone?

Yes! Use the highest video quality setting and film in landscape mode if possible—it makes your video easier to watch and more professional. Keep your footage steady, well-lit, and clear so your message stands out.

Q. Can I use music, images, or other media in my video?

Yes, but everything you include must be **original or free to use with permission** (such as royalty-free or public domain content).

All media must be appropriate for a student audience, free of curse words or brand references, clearly visible or audible, and high quality to support your message.

Do not include:

- Copyrighted songs (even short clips or background music)
- Brand logos (e.g., clothing, electronics, food packaging)
- Popular public figures (e.g., celebrities, influencers)
- Content from copyrighted or trademarked media (e.g., game shows, reality TV shows, movies, or recognizable characters)

Videos that include restricted content may be disqualified.

Tips for Your Video

- Focus on energy efficiency and saving resources.
- Include quantifiable savings information from a .gov source like energy.gov/save.
- Use good judgment no horseplay or unsafe behavior.
