2020 Conserve to Preserve Kids and Conservation® Video Contest Details, Terms and Conditions

New Jersey Natural Gas (NJNG) invites all high school students within its service territory, including those who are home-schooled, to participate in our 10th Annual **Conserve to Preserve (CTP) Kids and Conservation Video Contest**.

To get you started, we'll provide all students with a starter kit, including a booklet filled with energy-saving tips for students to choose from as a theme for their videos. Contest Rules

Each student is responsible for coordinating their entries, using the following guidelines:

- **To register:** Contact Carolyn Cannon at 732-938-1035 or ccannon@njng.com. You'll receive an email with a starter kit, details and deadlines.
- **Eligibility requirements:** Open to all high school students within NJNG's service territory
 - traditional or home-schooled students 13 years of age or older
 - minors must ask parent's or legal guardian's permission prior to submitting an Entry in this Contest.
- **Video requirements:** Videos can be submitted as an individual or group project, and must:
 - be no longer than two minutes in length
 - feature energy conservation efforts or ideas, with an **emphasis on natural gas such as heating, water heating and cooking**. Visit the [Save Energy & Money section of njng.com](#) for resource materials for your video. Natural gas conservation efforts should be the focus of the video.
 - include the theme words "Conserve to Preserve®"
 - be student's own original work

The following information must be included with the video:

- Student's name, phone number and email address
 - Student's school or home school association and phone number
 - Name of designated school representative (teacher, administrator or guidance counselor) or home school association representative
- **Submission details:** Entries must be submitted by end-of-day on Monday, November 30, 2020. Videos should be submitted via email to njngvideos@gmail.com.
 - **Winner selection and prizes:** NJNG team members will judge the videos based on content, accuracy, creativity and overall presentation. NJNG will notify winners in January 2021, and *award the prizes to all winners*. All participating students will receive a certificate of recognition for their involvement.

NJNG will select winners in one of two categories: individual and group

- Individual entry: **\$500**
- Group entry: **\$2,500 for students' group or club**
- **\$1,000 contribution to the student's school** or home school association for an energy conservation or environmental project

Winning videos will be featured on njng.com. Plus, the winner of the Viewers' Choice award will receive **\$500** (the videos of finalists will be featured at njng.com/education where the public will vote)

- **Potential use of video:** The winners' videos, names and schools may be used in various NJNG communications including, but not limited to, social media, including NJNG's YouTube, e-newsletters, websites and more.

- This Contest starts on October 5, 2020, and ends at 11:59 p.m. ET on November 30, 2020.
- Only legal residents of the State of New Jersey within NJNG's service territory who are at least 13 years of age or older at the time of entry and are a high school student, including those who are home-schooled, can enter.
- This Contest is void outside the geographic area described above and wherever else prohibited by law.
- Participating students must have obtain any, and all, consents, approvals or licenses required for to submit entry.
- The video cannot otherwise violate the rights of any other person or company by using their trademarks, music, logos, names or images without their express written consent.
- If you are immediate family (sibling or child) of a New Jersey Resources Corporation ("NJRC") employee, or of any employee of an NJRC subsidiary, you are not eligible to submit an individual Entry (however, you will still be eligible to be part of a group submitting a group Entry).
- By entering this Contest, you (and your parent or legal guardian if you are a minor) agree to abide by these Official Rules and to release and hold harmless New Jersey Resources Corporation, its subsidiaries, employees and agents from any, and all, liability or any injury, loss or damage of any kind arising from, or in connection with, this Contest or any prize won.

How Will My Entry be Potentially Used? By submitting your Entry, you (and if you are a minor, your parent or legal guardian) are granting us an irrevocable, royalty-free, worldwide right and license to: (i) use, review, assess, test and otherwise analyze your Entry and all its content in connection with this Contest; and (ii) feature your Entry and all its content in connection with the promotion of this Contest in all media. You also agree that NJNG may use your proper name, state and municipality of residence online and in print, or in any other media in connection with this contest.

How will Entries be Judged and What are The Prizes? A panel of judges will review all eligible Entries received and select winners. The decisions of these judges are final and binding. NJNG will display the finalists' Entries on our Web site, *njng.com*, where the public will vote for an additional Viewer's Choice award.

- Individual video winner will receive \$500
- Winning group submission will receive \$2,500 for the students' club or class
- Online Viewers' Choice winner will receive \$500
- Winning students' schools or home school associations also will receive a \$1,000 contribution toward an environmental or energy conservation project
